The Property

Charming mid-terraced property situated in the heart of the sought-after village of Ley Hill close to Ley Hill Common. The home combines charm with modern practicalities making it an ideal retreat for those seeking village living with convenient amenities nearby.

Ley Hill is a desirable hamlet in the Chilterns located close to the town and amenities of Chesham. The village has an attractive common, golf course and cricket club, two pubs and a junior school.


Chesham has a pedestrianised High Street which features numerous individual shops and coffee shops alongside Waitrose & Sainsbury's. Chesham also has a variety of attractions including a theatre, leisure centre and openair heated swimming pool.

The area offers an excellent range of schools including Chesham Grammar School, Chesham Preparatory School, Dr Challoner's Boys Grammar School in nearby Amersham, and the Chiltern Hills Academy. Chesham Metropolitan line station offers fast services into Central London and The City beyond. The M25 and M40 motorway and A41 road networks are also easily accessible from the property.
